PICK-UP

⌚ 12:00 – 13:40 h SUMMER (April - Oct)

⌚ 10:00 - 11:40 h WINTER (Nov - Mar)

The tour begins with pick-ups from the south of the island in Puerto de Mogán. We will then proceed to collect passengers in sequence towards Las Palmas, which will be our final pick-up point before heading to our first stop.

PICO DE BANDAMA

⌚ 30 minutes

Begin your adventure at **Pico de Bandama**, where you will enjoy **breathtaking views** of the island from one of its most iconic peaks. The panoramic vista offers a unique opportunity to appreciate the diverse landscapes of Gran Canaria, from rugged mountains to the Atlantic coastline. Our expert guide will explain the island's complex **climate zones** and the **volcanic forces** that shaped this dramatic landscape. This stop sets the tone for understanding the **natural and geological wonders** you'll explore throughout the tour.

INNER VIEWPOINT OF CALDERA DE BANDAMA

⌚ 30 minutes

At the **Bandama Caldera**, delve into the heart of Gran Canaria's **volcanic past**. This impressive **explosive caldera**, formed by volcanic eruptions thousands of years ago, offers a striking contrast between the lush vegetation inside and the rocky, barren slopes surrounding it. The guide will provide insights into the **geological processes** that created this natural marvel, explaining how **volcanic activity** has played a crucial role in shaping the island. It is a perfect spot for photography and contemplation of the earth's raw power.

CRUZ DE TEJEDA

⌚ 40 minutes

This high-altitude mountain pass is not only a crossroads of ancient paths but also a **hub for local artisans**. Here, you will have the opportunity to taste **traditional Canarian delicacies** and, if you wish, purchase some to take home. The guide will share the history of these local products and their importance to the island's heritage, making this stop a cultural and sensory highlight of the tour. You will also enjoy incredible views of the **Caldera de Tejeda**, a **collapsed basin** that showcases the island's dramatic geological past.

TAJINASTE RESTAURANT

⌚ 1 hour

Enjoy an **original meal** at **Tajinaste Restaurant**, where **local Canarian ingredients** are creatively combined with **fusion cuisine** for a unique culinary experience. This lunch stop is a moment to relax, savor delicious food, and connect with fellow travelers. The ambiance of the restaurant and the unique dishes served make this a memorable part of the tour.

ROQUE NUBLO

⌚ 1 hour and 30 minutes



Embark on a hike to **Roque Nublo**, one of the **most iconic natural landmarks** in Gran Canaria. The trail is approximately 3 kilometers round trip, with a **moderate incline** of around 200 meters. The hike is rated as **moderately challenging**, suitable for most fitness levels, though it requires a reasonable level of physical fitness due to the rocky terrain. From the top, you will be treated to **stunning views** of the surrounding landscapes, including the **Sacred Mountains**, which are part of a **UNESCO World Heritage site**. The guide will share the cultural and natural significance of this area, making it an unforgettable highlight of the tour.

PICO DE LAS NIEVES

⌚ 40 minutes

Conclude your tour at **Pico de Las Nieves**, the **highest point** on the island, where you will enjoy a **spectacular sunset** over the sea of clouds. This viewpoint offers an amazing **panoramic view** of the island’s mountainous landscape, including the **Caldera de Tirajana**, an **erosional basin**, with the silhouette of **Mount Teide** in the distance, further enhancing the majesty of the view. The tranquility and unrivaled vistas provide a perfect end to your day. It’s a moment to reflect on the **natural wonders** you’ve experienced throughout the tour.

RETURN

⌚ 1 hour and 30 minutes

As twilight embraces the island, our minivan will transport you back to the pick-up point, concluding a day of exploration, emotion, and elevated experiences.
